Overview

The Chopta-Tungnath-Chandrashila trek is one of the most popular and scenic treks in Uttarakhand, known for its breathtaking views of the Himalayan peaks like Nanda Devi, Trishul, and Chaukhamba. Starting from the picturesque village of Chopta, the trail passes through dense forests and meadows leading to Tungnath Temple—the highest Shiva temple in the world—and further up to Chandrashila Peak, which offers a 360° panoramic view of the snow-clad mountains

March to May and October to December

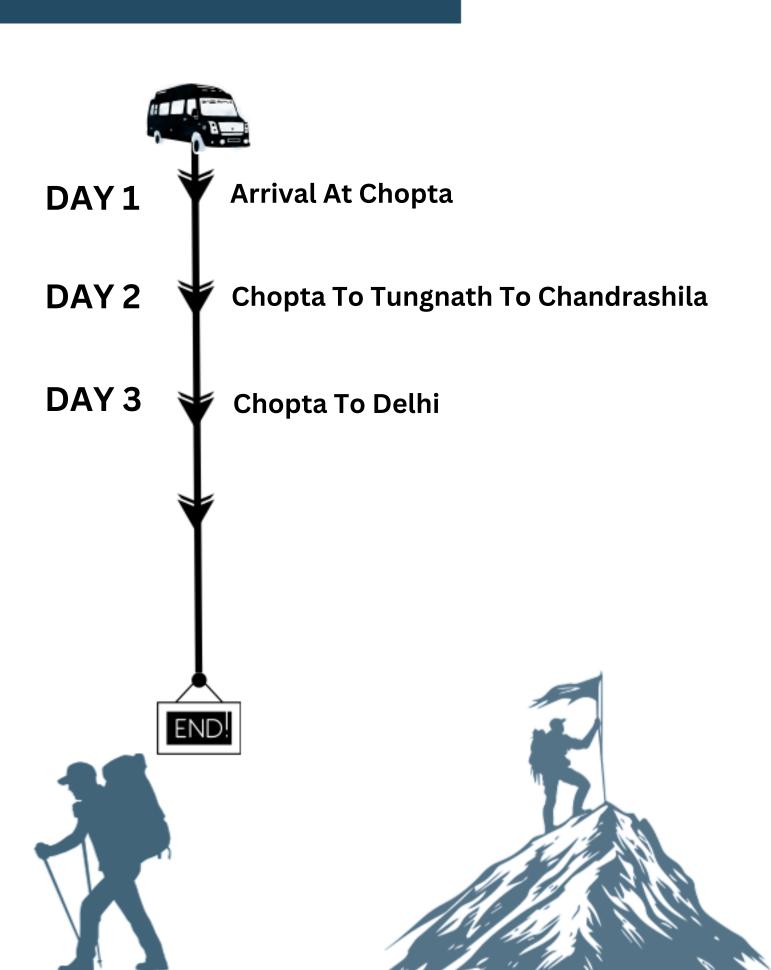


TUNGNATH & CHANDRASHILA TREK ROUTE MAP





SHORT ITINERARY





Day 1: Arrival At Chopta

OS Trek Distance: 415.6 Km

Travel time: 9-10hours by road



Altitude: 8,888ft



- Upon arrival at your pickup location in delhi, we will transfer you to Chopta
- Following check-in to your hotel or camp, you will have the opportunity to explore the village and surrounding areas.
- Overnight accommodations will be provided in Chopta.

Tip: Start your trip early from Delhi to avoid city traffic and enjoy a smooth highway drive. Keep warm clothes easily accessible — the temperature drops as you approach the hills and also Carry dry snacks, fruits, and enough water to stay refreshed on the long drive.





Day 2: Chopta To Tungnath To Chandrashila

Trek Distance: Chopta to Tungnath: 4Km

Tungnath to Chandrashila: 1.5Km (Approx.)

Travel time: 6-8 hours

Altitude: Tungnath: 12,073 ft, Chandrashila: 13,418 ft



- Commence a 3.5-kilometer trek from Chopta to Tungnath, anticipated to take 2-3 hours.
- Undertake a subsequent 1-kilometer trek to Chandrashila peak, estimated at 1-2 hours.
- Observe the breathtaking Himalayan vistas.
- Return to Chopta, allowing 5-6 hours for the descent.
- Secure overnight accommodations in Chopta.

Tip: Wear sturdy trekking shoes — the trail can get steep and rocky. Keep a refillable water bottle; there are limited water sources on the route and also carry a lightweight raincoat — mountain weather changes unexpectedly.



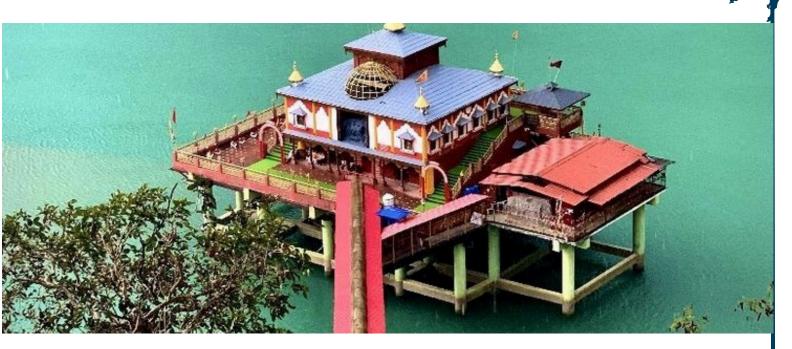
Day 3: Chopta To Delhi

O Trek Distance: 415.6 Km

Travel time: 9-10hours by road



Altitude: 8,888ft



- We will travel from Chopta to Sari village (approximately 30 kilometers, requiring one to two hours).
- A trek of approximately two kilometers from Sari village to Deoria Tal is anticipated, taking one to two hours.
- The return journey to Delhi via Rudraprayag, including a visit to the Dhari Devi Temple in Srinagar.

Tip: Stop at a local dhaba to enjoy authentic Garhwali food before leaving the hills.

- Lip balm, sunscreen, moisturizer

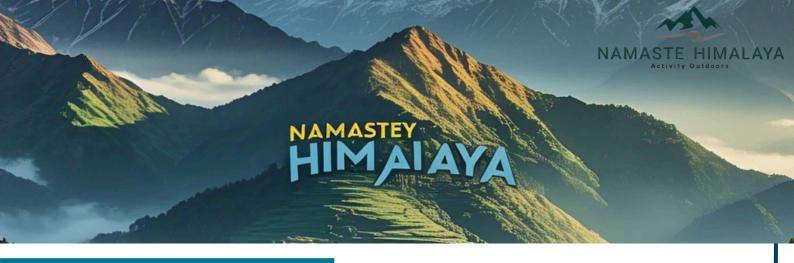

- Fitness First Do basic cardio and stretching before the trek.
- Hydrate Well Carry a water bottle and keep sipping.
- Layer Up Pack light but warm layers for changing weather.
- Trekking Shoes Good grip shoes are a must.
- First Aid Kit Keep band-aids, pain relief spray, and personal medicines.
- Follow Guide Always listen to trek leader's instructions.
- Pace Yourself Walk slow and steady, don't rush.
- Keep the Mountains Clean Carry back your waste.



Points to Note

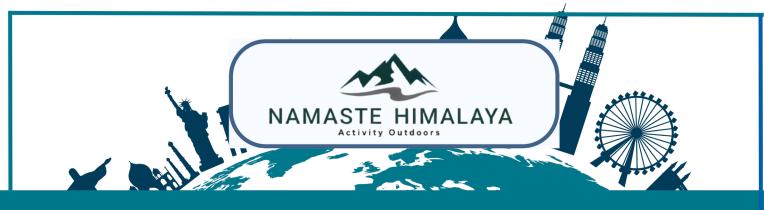
